

Agenda items

- 1. Call meeting to order-Mike called the meeting to order at 7:01pm.
- 2. Adoption of Agenda-Jessica adopted the agenda.
- 3. Minutes September 16, 2021- Shelinda adopts the minutes from the last meeting, Jessica seconds.
- 4. Financial report-\$940.30 in account, still have to pay Trevor for the SLC teacher meals. The bill was a little more than expected (over \$350) and Trevor used the school account to pay.
 - 1. Lisa motioned to approve Jessica Griffin, Mike Peifer as signing authority for our account, Amanda seconds.
- 5. Fundraising
 - 1. Book Fair \$2686- all the money goes back into buying books in the library
 - 2. Terry Fox Walk \$1966.30- classes were staggered during the walk with the intention that classroom cohorts would stay together; teachers had classroom challenges and rewards for raising money
- 6. Learning Improvement Plans Trevor reviewed the learning improvement plans with the SCC explaining the process, the acronyms, and some things Wagner is implementing specifically (Wagner way coupons, Reading BINGO, students have the opportunity to have a daily check in with teachers) No questions arise from the learning improvement plan review. Lisa motioned to approve Learning Improvement Plans, Jessica seconds
- 7. Education Week Each grade was given a technology day (Monday Oct 18 -grade 4, Tuesday Oct 19- grade 6, Thursday Oct 21-grade 5), Wednesday Oct 20 was a spirit day where students could wear sunglasses and a hat. They decorated

- sunglasses stating why their future's so bright. Friday Oct 22 is school wide Kahoots with small prizes for class winners.
- 8. COVID Protocol Changes -It has been a rough start to the school year with COVID cases but fortunately no one has been seriously ill. As of right now, if a positive case occurs in the classroom, children who are considered contacts can still attend school provided they don't have any symptoms. Adults who are not fully vaccinated need to be isolated for 14 days. The school has run out of test kits for families, so Trevor has started a waiting list, hoping to get some more by Friday. Lisa mentioned that the Chamber office will be getting some as well.
- 9. Principal's report

 - 2. Staffing Teesa Opp was supposed to be at Wagner teaching grade 5, but L.P. Miller was short staff so she is staying there; Keegan Bowman will be grade 5 teacher for 2021/22 school year. Jeanne Hosaluk was hired on as a permanent member of the support staff.

 - 1. Guided Reading work
 - 2. Learning Communities teachers working together to build and develop instructional plans to support students that struggle within the classroom (responsive instruction work)
 - 4. Student Led Conferences Thanks for the supper
 - 1. Feedback from conferences: it would be nice to see teachers and classrooms in person, but with the times it's understandable why we can't. The phone/google meets are convenient as there is no need to rush home from work and then rush to the school to make your appointment. Time limits for phone calls can be restraining at times, when there are lots you want to discuss. The parent participant numbers are down from last year.
