Universal Expectation: Being Respectful to others

Name of Skill/Setting: Showing Respect at Wagner School

Purpose of the Lesson

1. We are seeing more and more incidents of students not showing respect to other students
2. Students are telling others who to be friends with
3. Students are not getting along with each other in class and on the playground – Students are not feeling as safe as they should while at school.

Teaching Examples

1. Wagner Way examples of respect
2. Being respectful to other students that want to play at recess
3. Showing respect to learning by trying your hardest in class and not giving up

Student Activities and Role Plays

1. Role play a group of students wanting to play a game and one student is not playing fair – how do we deal with this
2. Groups of students excluding another student
3. Students getting along in class and how they deal with students that are having a bad day in the classroom.

Follow up/Reinforcement Activity

1. Keep respect level high, behavior referrals low - charts
2. Report when you see respectful behavior on the playground or in the classroom.
