Agenda items

- 1. Call meeting to order- Mike called the meeting to order at 7:07pm
- 2. Adoption of Agenda- Trevor N asked to add Christmas Concert to the agenda. Jessica motioned to adopt the agenda, Trevor S seconds
- 3. Minutes September 22, 2022- Reviewed the minutes from the September 22 meeting. Lisa motioned to adopt the minutes from the September 22 meeting.
- 4. Financial report- we currently have \$210.09 in our bank account and are waiting for our grant money to come in. The grant money amount varies depending on how many kids are enrolled in Wagner.
 - 1. Motion: to approve Jessica Griffin, Mike Peifer as signing authority for our account- *Jan motions, Carnie seconds*.
- 5. Fundraising- The book fair went well. Thank you to Jessica for organizing the volunteers to help run it. It was nice to have a debit machine at the book fair, lots didn't realize we had debit and weren't going to buy books, but when they found out we had the machine they changed their mind. It will have to be advertised in April that we will have a debit machine for book fair. Terry Fox fundraising did well. The kids enjoyed pieing the teachers in the face and dressing up Mr. Norum and Mrs. Ernst
 - 1. Book Fair -30% of \$3,037.25 = \$856.50
 - 2. Terry Fox Walk \$3,346.33
- 6. Learning Improvement Plans these are created to present to the ministry of education. Currently working off year old data. Key focus areas are reading and writing- while we are seeing growth in these areas, it's not near what the numbers are presenting. Lots of kids on individualized learning plans and trying to encourage kids to read because they want to and not because they have to.
 - Motion to approve our goals- Jessica motioned to approve goals, Jan seconds, carried.
- 7. Education Week- currently education week and the theme is "Reaching for Tomorrow, Celebrating Today". Have seen lots of parent interaction and getting into the community. Students have visited Wild Bill's Pizza, Bison Ranch, Schmidt

farm, The Nipawin Resource Centre, and an ambulance was even brought in. The week will conclude with a pancake breakfast on Friday.

 - 3. November 21 School Improvement Planning Day- a day where the teachers can learn from each other and add resources to their daily teaching.

 - 3. Learning sprints to support students that struggle within the classroom (responsive instruction work)- the principal and teachers holding each other accountable and not just principal holding teachers accountable.
 - 4. Student Led Conferences Thanks for the supper
 - 1. Feedback- Some conferences ran late so it made it challenging to be on time for other conferences with other teachers/at other schools. Hard to be in multiple places at the same time when all 3 schools are running the SLC on the same days and you have multiple kids in each school. L.P. Miller ran their awards ceremony on Thursday night and some parents had to miss because of being committed at SLC. Suggestion to stagger the interview days between the 3 schools with minimal overlap. The purpose of having SLC so early in the year is for parents and teachers to get to know one another and establish the "open door" policy.
 - 5. Christmas Concert- It was decided not to have a Christmas concert this year but instead have a family fun night celebration. Ideas for the evening include: Santa reading stories in the library, family bingo in the gym, cookie decorating. More information to follow but the date will be Thursday December 15.

Agenda items

- 1. Call meeting to order- In Mike's absence, Jessica was nominated to chair the meeting. She called the meeting to order at 7:03pm.
- 2. Adoption of Agenda- Trevor N asked if we could add book fair to the agenda. Lisa adopts the agenda and Trevor S seconds.
- 3. Minutes- Reviewed the minutes from the AGM (September 16, 2021) and from the June 22, 2022, meeting, Lisa adopts the minutes and Trevor S seconds.
- 4. Financial report- Currently have \$746.09 in our bank account. Lisa had made a motion over email to buy Smile cookies from Tim Horton's for the teachers (cost \$36.00) Shelinda seconded (via e-mail). Jessica formally made a motion in our meeting to purchase Smile cookies and it was carried. Attached is a copy of email message. We still have \$500 coming out of our account to pay a portion of the welcome back to school bbq. Lisa adopts the financial report and Trevor S seconds.
- 5. Elections/Offices- The SCC needs 8 representative members, and the terms are 2 years according to the constitution. Trevor N recommends we make a motion to nominate members.

Carnie nominates Mike Peifer, Shelinda Hill, Jan Boughen, Amanda Ritthaler, Lisa Vavra, Trevor Salisbury, and Jessica Griffin, to be representatives, Trevor N seconds.

Trevor N then called for other nominations 3 times.

All the nominations are elected in the 2022-23 SCC. Trevor motions Trevor N and Carnie are the representatives of the school. Jessica seconds.

Jessica nominates Mike for Chair, Amanda seconds, carried.

Jan nominates Lisa for Vice-Chair, Jessica seconds, carried.

Lisa nominates Amanda for secretary, Trevor S seconds, carried.

Amanda nominates Jessica for treasurer, Jan seconds, carried.

Trevor N will be doing up a draft of plans to share with staff and then comes to SCC with for approval of Learning Improvement Plans. The final plans will need approval at the October meeting.

The sign up times will be posted through Edsby and parents can choose the time slot that is convenient for them to meet with the teacher. Jessica asked if Karen can post a message on Facebook on behalf of SCC looking for volunteers to help with the teacher meals. Jessica said she will coordinate the meals and volunteers.
- 9. Fundraising Activities

\$543.15 has been raised from the bottle drive. Sarcan is willing to partner with us for the entire school year for recycling donations. If anyone takes their recycling in, they can say they want it donated to the Wagner SCC. Jessica will pick up the money a few times a month and then give it to Karen to submit remittance forms to NESD/playground account. The SCC has approved this for the year. Jessica also brought up playground equipment. She said she talked to Chris Sylvester for possibly removing the swings. He said he might be able to do it for a very reasonable price or possibly free of charge. Once the swings are taken out, ideas of what could be put in its place were tossed around. The idea of adding in extra picnic tables or a gazebo/outdoor classroom space. Jessica said there are grants we can apply for but we need an exact goal that we are working towards. Trevor N asked for the winter to think it through and talk with staff and we can re-visit in the spring. The SCC would also like to add Co-op gift card fundraiser to fundraising activities for November 2022.

Trevor S motions to approve fundraising and Jan seconds.
