 1. *April 19, 2023 Meeting- Minutes of the April 19 meeting was reviewed and accepted. Motioned by Carnie and seconded by Amanda.*
4. Financial- *We currently have \$1,565.59 in our bank account. We still have an outstanding cheque to Jan for \$64.44 and we also need to pay Jan mileage for the Hudson Bay SCC engagement night. Trevor S motions to accept the financial report and Jan seconds*
5. SCC Engagement – *Hudson Bay- Trevor N, Carnie, Amanda, Jan went to Hudson Bay on April 25th. The evening was enjoyable- we received a tour of Hudson Bay School and had a delicious meal. After supper we listened to guest speaker Melissa McFarlane and after her presentation, we broke out into groups to brainstorm different ideas for SCC. The evening made us think about our role within the SCC and how we choose to spend the money we receive. It would be beneficial to talk to other SCC's to see what they do at their schools to engage parents and bridge the home/school gap. 3. *Staffing- Erin Ernst has accepted a vice principal position in Tisdale at the high school. Wagner's loss is Tisdale's gain. Looking at keeping the same amount of teaching positions here next year, some temporary positions need filling. If Arborfield school closes that will have some effect.*

The drama program received some new mics in the fall and they have retired 4 mics. Mike motioned to buy some more mics for the program (4 mics cost \$250), Jessica motioned to buy 2 new sets of mics, Lisa seconds, carried.*
