- 1. Call meeting to order-Lisa called the meeting to order at 6:20pm
- 2. Adoption of Agenda- Carnie asked to add drama to the agenda. Trevor S motioned to approve the agenda, Jan seconds.
- 3. Minutes
 - 1. May 16, 2023, Meeting- Reviewed the minutes from the May 16th meeting, Jan motions to approve.
- 4. Introduction of Erik Kendrick and Kathy Chabot- Erik will be Wagner's new principal (coming from William Mason School in Choiceland), Kathy will be joining us as the new Vice-principal (coming from Central Park)
- Financial- our account is currently at \$1,501.15. We still have Jan's mileage cheque as outstanding as well as the Wagner Way Coupons (\$150)
 Amanda motions to approve the financial report, Trevor S seconds.
- 6. School Learning Improvement Plans- The learning improvement plans are updated every year. Reviewed the current plans and highlighted some areas that weren't completely fulfilled. The plan format will be changing and new workplans will be developed in the fall.

- 7. Parent Engagement previously held a grade 3 tour and then a parent information night to follow. With a new admin team coming, a parent information night is being planned for August 31st.
- 8. Fill a Backpack- supply a base amount. Suggested idea is that when we host the welcome bbg, everyone can bring a school supply item to donate to the program.
- 9. Gym Rental Ukrainian Dance Group no charge *The Ukrainian dance group has* applied for gym usage again in the fall. Traditionally, we have not charged them for usage. In lieu of rental fee, groups can give a donation directly to the school.
- 10. Video/Intercom Systems in 2023-24- system will be installed on June 29th. The front door will have a push button and the admin assistant will let them in.
- 11. Principal's report
 - 1. Student numbers-current 214
 - 2. Approve Supply Lists- reviewed the supply lists for the 2023-24 school year. Amanda motioned to approve, Jan seconds.

- 3. Grade 6 Farewell- held on June 16th, had 64 students attend a dance from 8-10pm and then swimming from 10pm-midnight It went very smoothly and we had lots of parents step up to volunteer. There was \$380 left over from the farewell so the grade 6 parents have voted to donate it back to the school on behalf of the 2023 Grade 6 class.
- 4. Staffing update- Kathy Chabot will be grade 4 homeroom. Permanent EA hired. Possible for afternoons 0.44, Megan Webster will be ½ time phys ed and ½ time grade 5. Same with Kegan Bowman. There will be 4 grade 6 homerooms in the fall.
- 12. Drama- Thank you to the SCC for purchasing additional microphones. Carnie called repair guy Mike to look at the old mics. He was able to disconnect 1 microphone that was affecting the others. By doing so, we gained 5 mics. Mrs. Stevens class has been using the microphones and they have been working well. Mike (repair guy) also offered to come in the fall to help set up and balance the sound system. Suggested we put a sheet on the back wall of the gym to help with the vibrations and make it easier to hear.
- 13. Next Meeting Date Sept 14, 2023 AGM 7pm.
 - How can we get people to sit on our council? We will have representation at the August 31st parent night explaining who the SCC is and what they do. Tentatively planning a welcome back bbq for September 7th and will have representation there as well.

- 1. Call meeting to order- Mike called the meeting to order at 7:18pm
- 2. Adoption of Agenda-Trevor S adopts the agenda
- 3. Minutes
 - 1. April 19, 2023 Meeting- Minutes of the April 19 meeting was reviewed and accepted. Motioned by Carnie and seconded by Amanda.
- 4. Financial- We currently have \$1, 565.59 in our bank account. We still have an outstanding cheque to Jan for \$64.44 and we also need to pay Jan mileage for the Hudson Bay SCC engagement night. Trevor S motions to accept the financial report and Jan seconds
- 5. SCC Engagement Hudson Bay- Trevor N, Carnie, Amanda, Jan went to Hudson Bay on April 25th. The evening was enjoyable- we received a tour of Hudson Bay School and had a delicious meal. After supper we listened to guest speaker Melissa McFarlane and after her presentation, we broke out into groups to brainstorm different ideas for SCC. The evening made us think about our role within the SCC and how we choose to spend the money we receive. It would be beneficial to talk to other SCC's to see what they do at their schools to engage parents and bridge the home/school gap. Some questions we thought of after that night were: What is the SCC? Who is on the SCC? Why does the SCC exist? We feel it is important that these questions are answered and parents understand what a SCC is and what it does. We need to educate and recruit new members. Suggested that we speak at the grade 3 parent night, have an information table set up at track and field, be present at the SLC to answer any questions, "spam" on Edsby, and give an update on the SCC monthly in the school newsletter.
- 6. Grade 3 and Grade 6 Transitions- Wagner will be doing grade 3 orientation nights for parents, and kids will come as classes to tour the school and meet the

teacher. Grade 6 transitions will be taking place soon. Carnie will be taking some students on individual tours to see the school and meet their teacher. The grade 6 group will go up as a class for orientation to tour the school and then they will find out who their homeroom teacher is.

- 7. SCC Workplans- Still working on the SCC linkage with the NESD Board of Education
- 8. Principal's report
 - 1. Student numbers- have another new student (grade 5 starting tomorrow-May 17)
 - 2. School Improvement Plans Trevor N to bring to June meeting
 - 3. Staffing- Trevor will be leaving his position as principal as he accepted a role as the Coordinator of Integrated Services. The principal position closed at noon on May 16. Need to hire a principal in place before a VP can be hired. Keegan Bowman has accepted a permanent position. Depending if an internal candidate applies and accepts an administrator role, could determine if more staffing needs are required.


